The OSHA #510 course covers OSHA Standards, policies, and procedures in the construction industry. Topics include scope and application of the OSHA Construction Standards, construction safety and health principles, and special emphasis on those areas in construction which are most hazardous.

Upon course completion students will have the ability to

define construction terms found in the OSHA Construction Standards, identify hazards which occur in the construction industry,

locate and determine appropriate OSHA Construction Standards, policies, and procedures,

describe the use of the OSHA Construction Standards and regulations to supplement an ongoing safety and health program.

Target Audience: Any worker acting as the Competent Person on the jobsite, those performing safety and health evaluations or training, site supervisors, owners, and those interested in gaining a more in-depth understanding of OSHA standards, policies and procedures. The OSHA #510 is a prerequisite to the #500 course.
