Topics include an Overview of a safety and health management system, Management leadership and employee involvement, Work site analysis, Hazard prevention and control, Safety and health training, and Program evaluation.

- Identify the core elements of an effective safety and health program
- Describe the key processes in each program element
- Evaluate, develop, and implement an effective safety and health management system
