The BlendedHeartsaver First Aid with CPR and AED Training Course is hybrid course which combines both online learning with a hands-on practical component designed to teach you to effectively recognize and treat adult emergencies in the critical first minutes until emergency medical services personnel arrive. The course provides a complete health and safety solution for First Aid, Adult CPR and AED. The First Aid component of this course prepares students to recognize and react to common situations such as low blood sugar, bleeding, broken bones and sprains, seizures, strokes, insect bites and stings, and temperature related injuries. The CPR and AED component of this course prepares students to recognize the signs of sudden cardiac arrest, when to activate the EMS system, and how to perform CPR. Students will become familiar with an Automatic Electronic Defibulator (AED) and how to successfully operate an AED in an emergency.
